- What were some of the religious and social beliefs of the Arabs before Islam?
- Define astrology and superstition
- What were some of the changes that Islam brought to Arabia?
- When did this period of ignorance end?

Lesson 6: The Year of the Elephant

- What was the Arabic term used to describe the year of the elephant?
- Why was Makkah an important city in Arabia?
- Be prepared to describe the story of Abraha.
- In which surah in the Quran is Abraha's story mentioned?

Lesson 7: Early Life of Muhammad (S)

- What was the custom for newborn babies in Arabia at this time?
- Which village did the Prophet (saw)'s nurse-mother belong to?
- Be prepared to list the names of the Prophet's family members including his grandfather, uncle, mother, father, and nurse-mother.
- Who took care of the Prophet (saw) after he was orphaned? Who took care of him after his grandfather passed?

Lesson 8: Life before Becoming a Nabi

- How old was Muhammad (saw) when he became a prophet?
- What tribe did Muhammad (saw) and his family belong to?
- What was the name of the Christian monk who predicted that Muhammad was going to be a nabi?
- What were the some of the nicknames given to the Prophet (saw) even before he became a nabi?
- Describe the story of Muhammad (saw)'s first wife and their marriage.
- Who was the prophet's adopted son?
- How did Muhammad (saw) solve some of the problems at a young age before he became a prophet?
- What was the name of the Cave in which he received the first revelation?

Lesson 9: First Revelation

- Why did Muhammad spend so much time in the cave before he became a prophet? What was he searching for?
- What was the first word revealed to the prophet (saw)? How did the prophet (saw) react to this experience?
- Who was Waragah ibn Naufal and what did he know?
