Here is a detailed description on how the Midterm exams will be graded:

- ❖ Memorization will be graded based on how well each student can recite the Surah from memory without any help from the book or the teacher.
- Pronunciation will be graded based on the student's ability to pronounce all the words in the Surah properly.
- ❖ The explanation will be graded on how well the student understands the meaning of the Ayat and the Surah as a whole
- ❖ There will be no written portion on the midterm exam for this class.
- 1. Surah 106: Al- Quraish (Page 36-37| Entire Surah)

Memorization: 60%Pronunciation: 20%

• Explanation: 20%

2. Surah 105: *Al-Fil* (Page 39-41| Entire Surah)

• Memorization 60%

• Pronunciation: 30%

• Explanation: 10%

3. Surah 104: *Al-Humazah* (Page 42-43| Only Ayat 1-4)

In this Surah, we have only covered the first 4 Ayat. Therefore the students will only be tested on the material covered.

• Memorization: 70%

• Pronunciation: 25%

• Explanation: 5%

The reason there is some variations in the way each Surah will be graded is based on how well the Surah was studied in class and the difficulties some students may have had. I also would encourage the students to spend extra time studying Surah Al-Fil since it is the Quran competition Surah for this class.
