Allah (swt)'s name Ar-Rahman means The Most Merciful

Allah (swt)'s name Ar-Rahiem means The Compassionate

We thank Allah (swt) for blessings by praying salah.

The Quran is the book of Allah (swt) and is written in Arabic.

The angel Jibril (A) delivered the Quran to Prophet Mohammad (sws)

The Quran is a book for all people that tells us to follow the right path.

A person who memorizes the Quran is called a hafiz.

Prophet Muhammad (sws) is the last prophet.

Prophet Muhammad (sws) always spoke the truth and told his people about the words of Allah (swt).

Salla Allahu 'alaihi wa Sallam means May Allah's Blessings and Peace be upon him.

The sayings and actions of the prophet (sws) are known as the Hadith.

The way the prophet (sws) lived is called the Sunnah.

Imam al-Bukhari was a wise person who collected only correct hadith.

Correct hadith are called Sahih.

Shahadah means that we believe there is no god but Allah (swt) and Muhmmad (sws) is His prophet.

Salah is done five times a day.

Sawm, or Fasting means that Muslims do not eat or drink during the daytime during the month of Ramadan.

Zakah, or charity means that we give part of our money to the needy.

Hajj is the pilgrimage to Mecca and must be performed at least once in every muslim's lifetime.

La ilaha illal-lahu means there is no god but Allah swt.

The shahada in arabic is Ash-hadu an la ilaha illal-lahu wa ash-hadu anna Muhammadur Rasulullah

The five salah are: Fajr, Dhuhr, Asr, Magrib, Isha

Jummah is a group prayer performed on Fridays.

The Adhan is a call to prayer that reminds us it is time for salah.

During salah we face towards the Ka'bah.

Fasting means to avoid eating or drinking from dawn to sunset.

When Ramadan ends we enjoy Eid al-Fitr.

People who travel to Mecca for Hajj are called pilgrims.

During Hajj we remember the Prophet Ibrahim (sws), his wife Hajar, and his baby son Ismail.

When Hajar became very thirsty she ran between two small hills called Safa and Marwah while she was looking for water.

Allah swt gave Hajar a spring of fresh water called Zamzam.

When pilgrims reach the Mecca, they walk around the Ka'bah seven times. This walking is called Tawaf.

The day people sacrifice an animal is called Eid al-Adha.
