## Ramadan Qur'an Contest 1439 AH/2018 AC

Assalamu Alykum Warahmatu Allahee Wa Barakatuh!

The Birmingham Islamic Society is pleased to announce that inshaaAllah the Community Annual Ramadan Contest will take place on Saturday 6/9/2018 (25<sup>th</sup> of Ramadan, 1439 AH) at Hoover Masjid. The competition is open to the entire community and will consist of four levels:

#### **Rules:**

- 1. Contestant can register in only one level.
- 2. Online Registration is a must.

- 3. Registration deadline is June 6, 2018 at midnight. No late application will be accepted.
- 4. Age is calculated from date of birth until June 8, 2017.
- 5. Contestants may compete in higher level according to their abilities, but not in lower level.
- 6. During testing, contestants may be asked to recite any part(s) of the Surah assigned to the level in which he/she are participating.
- **7.** Parents are advised to encourage their children to memorize new Surahs/Juzu's during the month of Ramadan.
- 8. All participants should abide by Islamic dress code.

#### Rubric:

- 1. Beginners Level: 95% of the score will be assigned to Memorization and 5% for Pronunciation.
- 2. Intermediate Level: 90% will be assigned to Memorization and 10 percent will be assigned to Tajweed. Tajweed rules for Intermediate level includes pronunciation, *An-Noon Saakinah* and *At-Tanween*, and *Al-Meem* and *An-Noon Al-Mushaddadatain*.
- 3. Advanced & Juzu' Track Participants Level: 90% will be assigned to memorization and 10% will be assigned to Tajweed. Tajweed rules for these levels will be limited to *An-Noon As-Saakinah* and *At-Tanween, Al-Meem and An-Noon Al-Mushaddadatain*, Compulsory Madd(*Al-Madd Al-Laazim*), Connected Madd (*Al-Madd Al-Muttasil*), Disconnected Madd (Al-Madd Al-Munfassil).
- 4. Tie Breaker: Tajweed Score will be used as a tie breaker in case of a tie.
- 5. Judges will use a more detailed rubric to evaluate the participants.

#### **Important Dates:**

- 1. Application Deadline: Wednesday, Ramadan 22, 1439 Corresponding June 6, 2018 at midnight.
- 2. Contest Date: Saturday, Ramadan 25, 1439 Corresponding June 9, 2018.
- 3. Result Announcement Date: Saturday, Ramadan 26, 1439 Corresponding June 10, 2018. It will be announced during *Taraweeh* Prayers.
- 4. Award Ceremony Date: To be announced.
