Rules:

1. Contestants can register in only one level.
2. Online Registration is a must.
3. Registration deadline is Sunday, May 2, 2021 at midnight. No late applications will be accepted.
4. Participation is by grade and not by age.
5. During testing, a contestant may be asked to recite any part(s) of the Surah assigned to the level in which he/she is participating.
6. Parents are advised to encourage their children to memorize new Surahs/Juzu's during the month of Ramadan.
7. Tie Breaker: Tajweed Score will be used as a tiebreaker in case of a tie.
8. Judges will use a more detailed rubric to evaluate the participants.
